

To Whom it May Concern:

This memo is being written in response to a request made by the City of Redmond and Ogden Farms, LLC to have the Lake Washington School District Transportation Department speak to the transportation status of any students of Mark Twain Elementary School that will be living in the plat of Kirkmond (located near the intersection of 134<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE and NE 100<sup>th</sup> Street in Redmond Washington – see attached Exhibit “A”).

This memo serves as confirmation that students who attend Mark Twain Elementary School that live in the Plat of Kirkmond are currently bused to school. The district does not guarantee busing in the future. Improvements to walk paths and/or the addition of crossing guards could facilitate a walking path that would allow for the removal of bus service.

For students from the Plat of Kirkmond attending Middle School they will be outside of the current walk radius and will be bused. High School students will be eligible for Metro Passes; no district school buses are available from the Lake Washington High School attendance area.

Future changes in student demographics may require boundary changes that would also impact schools of attendance and related eligibility for bus service.
