June 9 Meeting Summary: Approved

Updates from Commissioners:

- Jason and staff have interviewed 3 candidates for the Commission vacancy and are recommending 1 to meet with the Mayor on 7/11.

Updates from Staff:

- The Mayor is not comfortable allowing members of human service agency boards to sit on the Commission because it may give the appearance of a conflict of interest. We will move forward on changing the ordinance to allow individuals with Redmond postal addresses (who may live outside the city limits) to join the commission.
- Alaric and other city funders have met with Therapeutic Health Services staff about their low service unit numbers. They are only being reimbursed for actual services rendered. They think they may have found errors in their data reporting and will be meeting with city staff on 7/1. We will continue to monitor closely.
