

# Project Description

The Redmond Central Connector Phase II project will continue construction of a regional trail corridor from east of the Sammamish River to the intersection of Willows Road and the 9900 Block.

Key project elements include:

- A 1.3 mile, paved Regional Trail
- 17 foot width trail section, with 12 foot width pavement
- Re-use and retrofit of two existing railroad bridges
- Intersection improvements at trail crossings
- Landscape and Urban design improvements
- Art integration

# Project Schedule

The City of Redmond secured four miles of the former BNSF corridor and adjacent properties in 2010 in order to develop a regional trail system to connect the Willows business district to downtown Redmond and the Redmond Town Center. The project was then divided into a planning phase and three design phases, listed below:

- **Master Plan Development:**  
*Completed in 2011*
- **Phase I:** Bear Creek Trail to Sammamish River Trail—  
*Completed in 2014*
- **Phase II:**  
Sammamish River Trail to 9900 Block—  
*Currently In Design. Construction Anticipated to Start Summer of 2015 and be completed in Spring/Summer 2016*
- **Phase III:** 9900 Block to NE 124th Street—  
*Not Currently Funded*
