Ceramic Arts Internship:

Application due April 30th, 2016

Redmond Clay Studio is seeking artists to assist in teaching Clay Camps for the summer of 2015. This internship is designed to give artists a comprehensive experience in the field of ceramic art education. Interns will assist instructors in running clay camps for children and teens from June 22 – September 4. We run 11 weeks of camp; Monday – Friday, 9am–12pm and 1pm-4pm (or 9am-3pm for full day camps). The internship is open to all artists looking for experience in teaching children age 6-16 and having a passion for ceramic art.

Our camps are led by some of the best ceramic artists in the Northwest. The intern will gain knowledge of the ceramic art field, experience in childhood education, art education, ceramic studio management, and safety.

Qualifications: Ceramic Art Interns should have a passion for ceramics and art education. Ideal candidates are enthusiastic, have strong communication skills, and are self-driven to help others. Some experience with clay as an art material is required, preferably within a ceramic studio environment.

Description: This internship offers High School and College students the experience of teaching ceramics to children and teens.

Experience: The intern will gain experience in childhood education, art education, technical studio work, ceramic studio management, and studio safety. Skills gained include leadership and management, Studio technician responsibilities, ceramic art techniques, loading and unloading kilns, mixing slips and glazes, photographing art work, and program coordination.

Commitment: The intern will commit to being available for a Monday through Friday work week, either half day or full day. Clay Camps run Monday through Friday, 9am–12pm and 1pm-4pm (or 9am-3pm for full day camps) from June 20th – September 2nd. We do not require a full summer commitment, but more availability takes precedence.

Benefits: The intern will have access to a working ceramic art studio and materials to create their own art outside of work hours.

Upon Completion: The intern will receive a letter of recommendation or reference upon request, a certificate of skills gained, and a log of hours volunteered.
