Here are the requirements to participate in the multifamily food recycling program. Please check off the qualifications that your complex currently meet. We will help you meet the others. They are listed in the order they are needed for set up.

Discussed program with property manager, HOA, or condo association and received approval

Had a walkthrough of the property with a City representative

Have a recycling rate of over 50% (The City will calculate and let you know)

Have at least 10% of the complex's residents interested in participating

Have at least two residents willing to be Conservation Leaders

Attend an on-site training with a City recycling representative

Conduct resident education and outreach

Periodically check carts for contamination (non-compostable items)

If you meet the requirements to participate, the City will provide the following:

- Free outdoor food recycling carts
- Indoor kitchen food scrap buckets with label listing what can and cannot be recycled
- A free compostable bag sample
- On-site presentations and training
- Signage that lists what can and cannot be placed in food recycling carts
- Support to your Conservation Leaders
