- Josh reported Pastor Lara from Redmond United Methodist has been trying to convene faith community to talk about Homelessness Task Force follow up. Overlake Christian safe parking program going well with people transitioning into housing, good partnerships with other churches.
- All Home Redmond website launched last week. Derby Days booth successful.

#### Updates from Staff:

- All Home Redmond website is just the beginning of the homelessness education and awareness campaign. There will be more events over the coming year.
- Homeless outreach staff, Kent Hay, started today. Working closely with RPD.

#### Application Review:

Commission reviewed last 5 applications in Supportive Relationships category and all applications in Save Haven category. Staff will follow up with agencies with commissioners' specific questions.

#### Round Robin:

Council budget hearings are scheduled for Oct 18 and Nov 15. Commission will go to Parks and Human Services Committee meeting in September with recommendations, present at full Council study session in October.
