#### Funding Allocations:

Decided on final funding allocations to recommend to City Council at study session 10/25. Existing programs were given 2% COLA. For new programs or expansion of existing programs, priority given to Homelessness Task Force recommendations, responsiveness to changing demographics, and helping family support programs “catch up”. If additional funding were available, commission would recommend funding additional programs geared toward underrepresented communities and other programs need to “catch up”.

- Sue reported that interviews have been scheduled for 11/1 to fill Kellen’s seat.
