CHILD SEAT REQUIRED



A child seat is required for children 8 years old or younger, unless they are 4 feet 9 inches or taller. Any child seat must be provided by the passenger, must comply with United States Department of Transportation standards, and must be secured according to child seat and vehicle manufacturer instructions. 
