Comprehensive Plan Amendments: Emergency Preparedness

The City of Redmond Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing in the **Council Chambers, 15670 NE 85th Street, Redmond, Washington** on December 14, 2016, *at 7:00 p.m.* or as soon thereafter as possible, on:

SUBJECT: Amendments to the Comprehensive Plan regarding Emergency Preparedness. The amendments would expand on the direction of policies NE-15 and TR-38, which call generally for hazard mitigation and emergency preparedness planning but do not use language common in emergency preparedness and do not address the range of subject areas identified by the City of Redmond's Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan. The proposal includes policy amendments that provide direction for better integrating emergency preparedness with functional and strategic planning as applicable.

REQUESTED ACTION: Planning Commission recommendation on the proposed Comprehensive Plan amendments.
