## ***Project Updates:***

### **Park Planning Updates**

- Downtown Park – Council approved the contract for the public art, Reflection, fabrication and installation in December. The main contract will go out for bid in January. The [DJC ran an article](#) about the bid process for the park in December. The bid period will be open for most of January, with a big opening date of 2/2/17 and an estimated award of contract on 3/7/17. Construction should begin in May 2017 and is anticipated to be completed in summer 2018.
- Redmond Central Connector - A winter shutdown is in effect until Spring, when conditions improve for paving.
