

CITY OF REDMOND
ORDINANCE NO. 2498

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING
RMC 2.28.010, DISABILITY BOARD, MEMBERSHIP,
SPECIFICALLY TO ALLOW ALTERNATES BY ELECTION
TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ABSENCE OF MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the Redmond Disability Board currently appoints the candidate who places second in the elections for its positions representing firefighters and law enforcement officers plan 1 to serve as an alternate in the absence of the respective board member; and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Disability Board desires to ensure the legality of the current practice of allowing alternate representation of certain of its members.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the city code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section. RMC 2.28.010, Disability Board, Membership, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Pursuant to RCW 41.26.110, the Redmond Disability Board is established, which shall consist of two members of the City Council to be appointed by the

Mayor, one firefighter to be elected by the majority vote of city firefighters under LEOFF Plan 1, one law enforcement officer to be elected by the majority vote of law enforcement officers under LEOFF Plan 1, and one citizen from the public at large residing within the city to be appointed by the four other members appointed and elected. The candidate who places second in the elections for the law enforcement officer and firefighter representatives shall serve as an alternate to the respective first place finishers.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five days after its passage and publication of a summary as provided by law.
