

ORDINANCE NO: 2399

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RMC 2.04.070(d)(3)(B), AGENDA, ORDER OF BUSINESS, TO MOVE THE "COMMITTEE REPORTS" SECTION OF THE AGENDA TO THE "REPORTS" SECTION OF THE AGENDA, AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL AMENDMENT TO THE SAME SECTION OF THE CODE.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Redmond City Code.

Section 2. Amendment of subsection. RMC 2.04.070(d)(3)(B), is hereby amended to read as follows:

(d) Order of Business. The order of business shall follow as nearly as possible the order of the agenda as follows:

(1) Items from audience (a maximum of four minutes per speaker);

(2) Consent agenda (including approval of minutes and voucher and warrant approval);

(3) Hearings and reports:

(A) Hearings:

(i) Hearing (a maximum of four minutes per speaker, provided, that the Council may, in its discretion, allow additional time where the complexity of issues involved requires more time in order to give the speaker a reasonable opportunity to be heard on the matter),

(ii) Passage of any applicable ordinance or resolution,

(B) Reports:

(i) Staff reports,

(ii) Ombudsman reports;

(iii) Committee Reports: when it is determined that the city council needs to vote on a committee report item other than to establish a meeting date or direct the committee to study any issue, the city council shall place the item needing a

vote on the council agenda for a subsequent city council meeting under [OLD] unfinished or new business;)

- (4) Unfinished business;
- (5) New business;
- (6) Ordinances and resolutions;

~~[(7) COMMITTEE REPORTS: (WHEN IT IS DETERMINED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL NEEDS TO VOTE ON A COMMITTEE REPORT ITEM OTHER THAN TO ESTABLISH A MEETING DATE OR DIRECT THE COMMITTEE TO STUDY ANY ISSUE, THE CITY COUNCIL SHALL PLACE THE ITEM NEEDING A VOTE ON THE COUNCIL AGENDA FOR A SUBSEQUENT CITY COUNCIL MEETING UNDER OLD OR NEW BUSINESS);]~~

- (8) Adjournment.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect five days after its publication, or publication of a summary thereof, in the City's official newspaper.


