

## Proposed City of Redmond Stormwater Credits

Qualifying systems may be assigned up to one water quantity and one water quality credit.  
Credits are allocated proportionally for sites with multiple systems.

### Water Quantity

|                         | Description   | Examples  | Discount |
|-------------------------|---|---|----------|
| <b>High Performance</b> | Designed systems that prevent the majority of runoff from leaving the site.   | <i>Rainwater Harvesting and Reuse<br/>Full infiltration or dispersion<br/>LID Performance Standard + Flow Control</i> | 40%      |
| <b>Full Control</b>     | Designed systems that control the majority of runoff from the site.   | <i>Detention (2001 Standard)<br/>Private Direct Discharge<br/>Infiltration (91% annual runoff volume)</i>             | 20%      |
| <b>Partial Control</b>  | Designed systems that partially control the runoff from the site.   | <i>Detention (1992 Standard)<br/>Rainwater Harvesting (State Definition)</i>  | 10%      |
| <b>Other Controls</b>   | Designed systems that reduce or control runoff in some manner but do not meet the criteria above.<br>Typically older systems. | <i>Other designed flow control<br/>Other designed infiltration<br/>LID Performance Standard</i>                       | 5%       |

### Water Quality

|                 | Description   | Examples  | Discount |
|-----------------|---|---|----------|
| <b>Advanced</b> | Designed system that separates runoff from non pollution generating surfaces.                             | <i>Infiltration of non pollution generating surfaces<br/>Rainwater Harvesting and Reuse</i>       | 20%      |
| <b>Enhanced</b> | Designed system that removes sediment, metals, and/or phosphorus to current ecology standard.             | <i>Enhanced Treatment</i>   | 15%      |
| <b>Basic</b>    | Designed system that removes sediment to current ecology standard.  | <i>Basic Treatment</i>  | 10%      |
| <b>Other</b>    | Designed systems that improve or monitor water quality in some manner but do not meet the criteria above. | <i>State or City Required Monitoring<br/>Oil/Water Separator<br/>Other designed water quality</i> | 5%       |
