**Update of the Redmond Park, Arts, Recreation, Culture & Conservation (PARCC) Plan and related Elements of the Redmond Comprehensive Plan**

The City of Redmond **Planning Commission** will hold a Public Hearing in the **City Hall Council Chambers, 15670 NE 85<sup>th</sup> Street, Redmond, Washington** on **January 11, 2017 at 7:00 p.m.** or as soon thereafter as possible, on:

**SUBJECT:**

The City of Redmond proposes to update the PARCC Plan and related elements of the Comprehensive Plan, such as the PARCC Element and Capital Facilities Element. The last PARCC Plan update was in 2010 and amendments are proposed to reflect changes in conditions since the last update; maintain the City's eligibility for grants from the Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office; maintain consistency with planning requirements related to the Growth Management Act and the Redmond's Comprehensive Plan; and clarify existing policies and add new policies to the Comprehensive Plan. The proposed amendments include updates to the Comprehensive Plan and PARCC Plan for levels of service; facility development; coordination; funding strategies; recreation, arts and cultural programs; trails; conservation; cultural arts; maintenance and operations; and planned capital projects. The PARCC Plan is Redmond's functional plan that addresses certain Growth Management Act requirements related to parks and recreation.

**REQUESTED ACTION:** Planning Commission recommendation on the proposed amendments.
